Caption: Columbia County Second Amendment Preservation Ordinance

Question: Shall Columbia County enact an ordinance that prohibits any infringement of the right to keep and bear arms?

Statement: The Second Amendment to the United States Constitution says: "(a) well-regulated militia being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the People to keep and bear arms, shall not be infringed."

Article 1, Section 27 of the Constitution of the State of Oregon says: "(t)he people shall have the right to bear arms for the defense of themselves, and the state, but the Military shall be kept in strict subordination to the civil power."

This ordinance would make it illegal for Columbia County to, in any way, limit the rights granted under the United States and Oregon Constitutions. Specifically, registration, use, ownership of firearms, including semi-automatic firearms, shall not be restricted. This prohibition extends to parts of firearms, such as magazines, ammunition, grips, bayonet mounts, flash suppressors and similar items. The Sheriff of Columbia County is directed to determine if any federal, state or local law infringes on the right to bear arms under the United States and State Constitutions within the County.

The Ordinance contains civil penalties.
